Benefits of Oriental Medicine & Acupuncture

In recent years, many traditional Western medical doctors and specialists have implemented complementary treatments rooted in the ancient systems of Oriental Medicine to support their patients' needs especially as they address fertility issues. Clinical trials demonstrate that acupuncture and Oriental Medicine increase the chances of conception. For example, researchers from Weill Cornell Medical Center ^[1] in New York reviewed studies and concluded that acupuncture helps to

- Improve implantation by increasing blood flow to the uterus
- Improve fertility significantly by reducing anxiety, stress, and the hormones that are secreted during stressful situations.
- Normalize hormone and endocrine systems that regulate ovulation/menstruation
- Positively affect the hypothalamic-pituitary-ovarian axis, which plays a key role in fertility

Other Reasons to Try Acupuncture:

- Relaxes painful spasms
- Promotes natural healing after injury or surgery
- Eliminates inflammation
- Improves circulation
- Influences the central and peripheral nervous systems
- Affects metabolism
- Releases endorphins to control pain
- Enhance the body's innate intelligence regarding health
- Addresses root causes leading to dysfunction using a holistic approach
- Provides a proven history of over 3,000 years, helping millions of people to wellness and health

In Vitro Fertilization (IVF)

IVF is an example where Oriental Medicine supports medical intervention. This approach can be used to strengthen, support, and balance overall health and well-being, so other fertility procedures are more effective. Clinical research validates that early intervention with acupuncture and herbal tonics increases the success rate of conception and improves the chances of achieving IVF implantation while reducing the side effects.

The highest conception rates occur with IVF when regular weekly treatments are given before, during, and after the IVF cycle. Although we recommend preparing the body well before IVF treatment begins; incorporating our program at any point provides a higher success rate.

Treatment is recommended regularly around the time of egg extraction and implantation. These treatments help to relax the uterus for collection and enhance the "holding" function of the implantation. Our treatment techniques support body, mind, and spirit to minimize your stress level and help you maintain a sense of calm to optimize conception.



After Conception

We recommend acupuncture during your pregnancy and birth. According to the World Health Organization, acupuncture has been found useful for relieving labor pain, nausea, vomiting, and significantly reducing the duration of labor. Studies also provide strong evidence that acupuncture can help with a breech birth. ^[1]

Men

Men's issues contribute to 50% of all infertility cases. Men, like women, experience complex hormonal rhythms that affect their mood, physical well-being, and their sexuality. Symptoms may include high levels of stress, irritability, worry, depression, fatigue, weight gain, sleep disturbances, and reduced libido.

The 3 major factors for male fertility:

- Sperm Count (40 million +)
- Motility (swim straight and strong)
- Morphology (shape and size)

Diet, lifestyle, herbal medicine and acupuncture are effective to improve a man's overall health and sperm quality. Treatments promote blood and energy circulation to the reproductive organs.

Studies have found that just 5 weeks of acupuncture can improve men's sperm quality.
